Day 1: Cancun

When you land our representative a person from [Cairo Top Tours](#) will be there to meet you at the airport. They will have a sign with your name on it. They will take you to your hotel in a nice car with air conditioning. Once you get to the hotel, they will help you check in and make sure you know when to be ready for the next part of your trip.

Day 3: Chichen Itza

We will drive for 1.5 hours from Cancun to Chichen Itza, which is a special ancient city of the Mayan people. It has amazing buildings and landmarks that are very old and important. Chichen Itza The Maya and Toltec people shared their beliefs about the world and universe through the statues and art they made. Chichen-Itza is a special place that shows how they combined their building skills with new ideas from central Mexico. It's an important example of their civilization in Yucatán. Then we will have lunch in a city called Valladolid, where there are pretty old houses.

Day 4: Cancun to Cusco

We are going to take a plane from Cancun to Cusco at a certain time. Cuzco and the area nearby have a lot of old Inca buildings that show how good the Inca people were at building things with stones. When we get to

Cusco Some of the walls they made are still standing today, and they were built so well that you can't even fit a matchbox cover between the stones.

we will take you to your hotel so you can rest and get used to the high altitude there.

Day 5: Aguas Calientes, Macchu Picchu

In the morning, we will take a train to Aguas Calientes. Aguascalientes is a town in Mexico that was named after the hot springs in the area. It became the capital of the state in the 1850s and now most of the people in the state live there.

We will leave our bags at the train station and then we will transfer you to the entrance of Macchu Picchu to start exploring. Machu Picchu is a wonderful place that was built a long time ago by the Incas. It's way up in the mountains and lots of people think it's amazing to see!

Later today, we will take you back to Aguas Calientes. There, you can relax and do whatever you want.

Day 6: Macchu Picchu, Ollantaytambo, Sacred Valley

Today, we can go back to the special Inca city to watch the sunrise over Macchu Picchu. We can also go on a hike up Huayna Picchu.

"Wana Picchu" means "Young Mountain". This young mountain is considered a communications and surveillance center due to its strategic location. In the afternoon, we will take a train to Ollantaytambo Station and visit the ruins of Ollantaytambo, one of the most important Inca ruins before Machu Picchu. Overnight in the Sacred Valley.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 7 is spent in Cusco.

After breakfast in the morning, you will go to Cusco early and then have the rest of the day to do whatever you want.

The Incas believed Cusco was the most important city in the world, like a belly button, and it was where their kings lived. They thought special lines of spiritual power spread out from Cusco to other important places. You can see the fancy palaces of Inca kings with strong walls when you explore the old city.

Day 8: Cusco to Rio de Janeiro

At the right time, we will get on a plane in Cusco and fly to Rio de Janeiro; is one of the most visited cities in the Southern Hemisphere and is known for its natural settings, carnival, samba, bossa nova, and balneario beaches such as Barra da Tijuca, Copacabana, Ipanema, and Leblon.

When we land in Rio de Janeiro, we will take you to your hotel where you can do whatever you want for the day.

Day 9: Christ the Redeemer

After we eat breakfast, we will go see a famous statue called Cristo Redentor (Christ the Redeemer), which is one of the coolest things in the world!

Later, we will take you to "Sugarloaf Mountain". The view of Rio from the top of Sugarloaf Mountain is beautiful. You will enjoy riding two cable cars up to the top, 395 meters above Rio.

At the peak, you can see the whole city below you, with a big mountain and a statue of Jesus to one side, and a famous beach to the other side. You can explore the city for the rest of the day.

You can have breakfast at the beach resort and then have some free time to relax. You can also choose to go on some fun activities with a local guide.
