## Itinerary

### **from Cairo Airport: a Layover Tour to pyramids, Coptic Cairo, and Felucca Ride on the Nile**

Your tour guide will pick you up from the [Cairo airport](#) and wait outside the arrivals area with a sign bearing your name to begin your tour of the great [Giza pyramids](#). Your tour will begin in front of the pyramid of King Cheops, which is still considered to be one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. You will then see the pyramids of King Chephren and King Mykerinus. then you may have a panoramic view of all three pyramids at once from the best spot on the Giza plateau.

then to the Valley Temple, which is a part of the Chephren Pyramids.

Following that, you will go to view the magnificent [Giza Sphinx](#), which is located at the base of the Pyramids and has a lion's body for a head and a pharaoh's body that dates to the reign of Chephren. It was found in 1912. halt to have lunch at a nearby eatery,

after that Continue to [Coptic Cairo](#) to see fascinating structures like the Hanging Church, which was constructed in the third and early fourth centuries. The Abu Sirga Church and Ben Ezra Synagogue, which date to the beginning of the 15th century AD, are both constructed in the Basilica style. It was erected over the cave where the Holy Family sought refuge in the basilica style. Visit the Amr Ibn El-aas mosque, Egypt's earliest mosque, to cap off your tour of Cairo.

Then, proceed to the bank of the Nile River to board your private felucca boat and explore the Nile as you cruise its waters. Enjoy some downtime while letting your hand drift along the Nile's surface and taking a warm sunbath in Egypt. After your Cairo Felucca Tour, be transferred back to the [airport in Cairo](#).
