Where the mummification of the king's corpse occurred before burial rituals. The Great Sphinx, which is said to have been sculpted from bedrock in honor of the same king and features a man-headed lion, symbolizing strength, will also be visited. You will then continue to the high plateau for a panoramic view of the three [pyramids of Giza](#) before indulging in a camel ride around them.

Half Day Tour from Dahab at Giza Pyramids with camel Ride

Early in the morning

a Cairo Top Tours representative will greet you at Cairo International Airport and transport you in a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle from your Hotel in Dahab to [Sharm El sheik International airport](#). when you reach cairo we will begin your exploration tour to Giza Pyramid including Camel Ride and lunch.

The first stop will be at the Giza Plateau where you'll witness the awe-inspiring Great Pyramid of King Cheops, one of the ancient seven wonders of the world. You'll also have the opportunity to view the pyramid of King Chephren and the Valley Temple, where the king's body was mummified before burial rituals. Additionally, you'll see the Great Sphinx, a man-headed lion carved from bedrock stone, which symbolizes the king's strength. Afterward, you'll head to the high plateau for a panoramic view of all three Giza Pyramids before embarking on a camel ride around them.

also, on this trip, we will take you inside the pyramid, there are three main chambers: the King's Chamber, the Queen's Chamber, and the Grand Gallery. The King's Chamber is the largest and most ornate, with a red granite sarcophagus where the pharaoh's body was placed. The Queen's Chamber is smaller and less decorated.

After that, you will enjoy a camel ride in Giza is a unique and popular activity for visitors to Egypt. The Pyramids of Giza make for a stunning backdrop as you ride through the desert on the back of a camel.

There are several free activities you can do at the Pyramids of Giza in Cairo, Egypt. Here are some suggestions:

1. View the Pyramids from the Giza Plateau: You can get a great view of the Pyramids of Giza from the plateau where they are located. This is a great spot for taking photos and admiring the size and grandeur of the pyramids.
 2. Visit the Sphinx: The Sphinx is a large statue of a mythical creature with the head of a human and the body of a lion. It is located near the Pyramids of Giza and can be visited for free.
