Itinerary

Day 1 - Luxor east and west banks Tour

you will be picked up from your hotel in Hurghada and transferred to Hurghada airport for your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, you will be greeted by our tour guide and taken on a tour of Luxor city to discover the important temples there,

visit the East Bank to discover the Luxor Temple which was built during the reign of Amenhotep the third, the tour guide will transfer you to the Karnak Temple, which is the largest man-made religious complex in the world has ever known and was the center of cult and administration during the time of the new kingdom. discover the history of Luxor Temple this temple was connected by a processional way to the temple of Karnak, which was built during the reign of Amenhotep ||, and completed by Ramses || who was the one who built the outer part.

then continue to visit the west bank to visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at <u>Deir Al-Bahari</u>, which was built between 2061-2010 B.C and was built by Queen <u>Hatshepsut</u> it is best known as El-Deir El-Bahari and inscribed with the divine birth story of the queen's majesty. visit the Valley of the Kings, where many of the Pharaohs of Egypt of the New Kingdom are buried including the tomb of King Tutankhamen, more than 60 tombs carved into the rocks have been discovered.

you can visit the Colossi of Memnon, and see the two massive seated stone statues signifying the pharaoh Amenhotep III, which are gigantic colossal statues of King Amenhotep III and the only ones that remain from his great temple.
