Your hotel will be visited by one of our representatives who will transport you to <u>Hurghada Airport</u>. Driving takes 02.30 hours. Fly to Cairo, where our representative will meet you and help you. Then, with the assistance of our Egyptologist guide, you will explore the magnificent Cheops, Chephren, and

Mykerinus <u>Pyramids</u>, the <u>Sphinx</u> with a pharaoh-like head and a lion-like body that dates to King Chephren's rule and With dimensions of 73 meters long, 19 meters wide, and 20 meters high, it is the biggest statue in the world. The monument has the earliest known sculpture in it., and the <u>Valley Temple</u> of the Chephren Pyramid The only one still standing on the Giza plateau is a granite mortuary temple that was used for mummification by the ancient Egyptians..

proceed to a neighborhood eatery in Cairo for lunch.

Then you will move on Coptic Cairo after that to witness intriguing buildings like the Hanging Church, which was built in the third and early fourth century. Both the Abu Sirga Church and the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which were built at the start of the 15th century AD, are examples of basilica architecture. It was constructed in the basilica style above the cave where the Holy Family took shelter. To conclude your trip of Cairo, go to the Amr Ibn El-aas mosque, which is the first mosque in Egypt.

After that, head to the Nile's bank to get on your personal felucca boat and sail the river's waters while exploring. Relax in Egypt while enjoying a nice sunbath and letting your hand float over the surface of the Nile.

You will be taken to the Cairo Airport in the evening to catch a flight to Hurghada. Arrival in Hurghada, followed by transport to your accommodation in Port Ghalib.
