period before the Pharaonic era until the modern times in Egypt, in addition to the cultural heritage of the local people of Sinai and its tribes, which makes it a cultural center and a meeting place for human civilizations, and one of the most important attractions not only among the things to do in Sharm El Sheikh but in all Egypt.

- The conference hall
- The basement
- A number of traditional crafts shops
- An open theater
- A number of restaurants.

The Sharm El Sheikh Museum of Antiquities exhibition hall includes wildlife and human life exhibition, and some tools, as well as aspects of the daily life of the ancient Egyptians.

The royal corridor is the main corridor that connects the two main halls of the museum, and it includes 10 artifacts of ancient Egyptian rulers, most notably Queen Hatshepsut and her father Thutmose I of the 18th dynasty, the hall of civilizations that passed through Egypt from the Pharaonic era until the modern era, and the life of the Sinai Bedouins.

Sharm El-Sheikh Museum has received nearly 6,062 artifacts, which will be displayed both inside and

outside the exhibition halls, in three halls: the Great Hall, the Corridor of Goddess Hathor, and the cemetery area.

The last pieces that the museum received were 10 artifacts from the King Tutankhamun exhibition returning from abroad, after having achieved great success in its stations abroad, which began in 2018, during which it visited Los Angeles in the United States of America and the French capital. Paris, London in England.
