Day Trip to Dendera and Abydos from Port Safaga

Cairo Top Tours' accurate tour leader will meet you from your cruise ship in Safaga Port to enjoy your Egypt Day Tours and discover the ancient sites during our Day Trip to Dendera and Abydos from Port Safaga.

You will be transported to visit the <u>Abydos temple</u>, the ancient Egyptians believed that <u>Osiris</u> (The Lord of the underworld) is buried there. The temple was built by King Seti I and accomplished by <u>King</u> <u>Ramsess II</u>, known as the temple of <u>Seti I</u>. It is located in the Sohag Government, approximately 135 km north of <u>Luxor</u>. The paintings of the Gods of ancient Egypt and the <u>Pharaohs</u> on the walls of Osiris Temple at Abydos are considered the most preserved in Egypt. Then resume to <u>Dendara</u> to visit the Temple of the cow Goddess <u>Hathor</u>, goddess of love, music, maternity, and joy, then you will be transferred back to your cruise ship in Safaga Port.
