Day 1: Luxor East Bank

Cairo top tours representative will meet you in your hotel then you will be transferred to Cairo airport and take your flight to Luxor to Embark on

then you will move to visit [the Karnak Temple](#) dedicated to Amun, Mut, and Khonsu. The largest religious building ever constructed.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank

After having your breakfast in the morning you will move to explore [the valley of the kings](#), which was a burial ground for the tombs of kings and queens. Then you will see the largest two massive stone statues Of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III "[the Clossai of Memnon](#)".

then you will visit "[El-dier el-Bahari](#)" which was built by Queen "Hatshepsut".

Day 3: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

In the morning you will be transferred to visit [the Kom Ombo temple](#) which was unique for its dedication to two different deities: the local crocodile-headed god Sobek.

then you will see [the Edfu Temple](#) As the largest temple dedicated to Horus, one of Egypt's most important historic deities.

Day 4: Aswan Temples

After having your breakfast onboard **the MS Jasmine Nile Cruise**, you will move to visit [the high dam](#) which provides irrigation and electricity for the whole of Egypt.

you will see [the Philae temple](#) is an island in the reservoir of the Aswan Low Dam, downstream of the Aswan Dam and Lake Nasser.

then you will discover [the unfinished obelisk](#) is the largest known ancient obelisk and is located in the northern region of the stone quarries of ancient Egypt in Aswan.
