Itinerary

Day 1: Luxor East Bank

our representative will meet you at your hotel to welcome you, then you will be transferred to Cairo airport and take your flight to Luxor then our tour guide will meet you to embark on **the MS Crocodile Nile Cruise**, then you will move to visit the Luxor temple which was built by 2 pharaohs, the inner oldest part was built by Amenhotep 3rd while the outer part was built and finished by king Ramses II.

then you will visit the Karnak temple is the largest religious build it is dedicated to the triet of Thebes.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank

after having your breakfast on the view of the Nile river you will move to see one of the most famous barrier places in Luxor which is the valley of the kings, the gateway to discovering knowledge of an ancient civilization that had been buried thousands of years ago.

then you will see the temple of Hatshepsut "<u>Elder el-Bahari</u>" on the west bank of Luxor. Made up of three man-made terraces that gradually rise up toward the sheer cliff face.

after visiting the valley of the kings and elder el-Bahari you will explore the largest cl status built by king Amenhotep the third "colossal of Memnon".

Day 3: Kom Ombo and Edfu temples

in the morning, after taking your breakfast you will visit The double temple of Kom Ombo is located on the eastern bank of the Nile in Upper Egypt, "Kom Ombo temple".

you will see the Edfu Temple is extensively considered to be the most impressive of all of the Nile-side temples along the trip between Luxor and Aswan.

Day 4: Aswan attractions

after taking your tea with breakfast aboard **the MS Crocodile Nile Cruise**, you will move to see the most famous sites in Aswan, beginning from the high dam It provides irrigation water and electricity for the whole of Egypt.

then you will explore the Philae temple which he dedicated to Isis, the mother of Horus, The temple of Isis was one of the last ancient Egyptian temples to remain active.

you will be discovering the unfinished obelisk lies in its original location in a quarry of granite in Aswan. It is 42 m. in height. Most probably it was abandoned in its place after discovering some cracks in the rock.
