Itinerary

day 1: Luxor attractions, (Luxor temple, Karnak temple)

On your first day of the MS Hapi 5 Nile cruise Luxor to Aswan, you will meet our professional tour leader holding the Cairo top tours sign at <u>Luxor international airport</u>, then you will be taken to the gorgeous MS Hapi 5 Nile cruise and visit:

<u>Luxor temple</u>: Luxor Temple was built to worship Amun-Re and his wife Mut and their son Khonsu; They are the gods who are also called the Theban Trinity (the Theban Trinity).

<u>karnak temple</u>: Tourists from all over the world flock daily to the Karnak temples to visit and enjoy the charm of the ancient Pharaonic civilization for thousands of years.

have your lunch on the board. then you will be offered to go to Karnak temple sound and light show, then have your dinner and get a comfy nice sleep.

Day 2: continue Luxor attractions.

on the second day of the MS Hapi 5 Nile cruise, Luxor to Aswan have a tasty breakfast on board then arrange yourself to start the journey.

cairo top tours tour leader will offer you an optional tour which is <u>Luxor hot air balloon ride</u>, to begin your day in the early morning by charming sightseeing from the above.

then start with the first site after you have your breakfast:

<u>the valley of kings</u>: The Valley of the Kings is located in the ancient city of Thebes, on the west bank of Luxor, and is an ancient tomb of the rulers of the New Kingdom of Egypt.

<u>Hatshepsut temple</u>: On the West Bank in Luxor, Queen Hatshepsut, "who received the title of Pharaoh, erected a splendid temple to commemorate her at Deir el-Bahari."

<u>Colosi of Memnon</u>: The throne displays reliefs and symbolic images of his mother, his wife, and the god Hapi. The architects built these statues to protect the mortuary temple of the king. However, today very little remains of the mortuary temple apart from the Colossi of Memnon.

End your day with an overnight on the comfortable board.

Meals of the day: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: sail to Edfu and Kom Ombo.

Start your third day of the trip 5 Days MS Hapi 5 Nile cruise Luxor to Aswan with a delicious breakfast then sail to Edfu and visit your first spot:

<u>Edfu temple</u>: The temple of Edfu and the Nile River connect a small underground riverbed, which was used as a measure of the Nile's flood in ancient times.

The site of the temple was chosen as a political objective of the pharaohs' kings to establish control over the south of the country.

Kom Ombo temple:

The Kom Ombo Temple is one of the most important tourist and archaeological sites in Egypt in terms of its architectural and religious distinction. The temple appears as consisting of two parts, separated by an imaginary line: Where the northern part was to worship the Holy Trinity of Horus. The southern part of the sacred Sobek worship

Day Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 4: sail to Aswan.

Day 4 of the MS Hapi 5 Nile cruise Luxor to Aswan tour will begin with breakfast to refill your energy in the early morning then you will be taken to the first site.

<u>Aswan High Dam</u>: Before its existence, agriculture used to go through two stages, the flood comes, the agricultural lands are inundated, and the crops are destroyed, or the flood does not come, and the lack of water required for agriculture leads to the collapse of crops and the fall of the land.

<u>Philae temple</u>: The Philae Temple embodied the greatest love stories of the goddess Isis and the god Osiris, between the walls of the towering columns, which you see decorated when your feet step into the roads of the temple, to see in that spacious courtyard, pharaonic, Roman and Greek inscriptions, and the columns decorated with gossip about history.
