Morocco 10 Days Tour

A journey through many different landscapes, rich history, and colorful culture is provided by the Morocco tour that takes ten days. The first stop in this tour is Casablanca where you will find yourself near Hassan II Mosque, which is among the biggest mosques globally. You may also want to check out Rabat's imperial city having its historical sites among other things.

Beginning in the blue city of Chefchaouen, known for its blue-washed buildings, your adventure across Morocco is set in motion. A stop-over at Fes, renowned for its medieval medina, will be seen. Following this camel ride and overnight stay in a desert camp, go further into the Sahara Desert. Visit Ait Benhaddou's kasbahs before winding up at Marrakech, famous for its souks and palaces. Finally, return to Casablanca to mark the end of this eventful Moroccan road trip.

Day 1: Arrival in Casablanca - Transfer to Rabat

In Casablanca when you come, an actual driver will meet you at the second gate outside the airport. You will journey up to Rabat which is the capital city of Morocco where you will be assisted to check in your hotel room where you are going to spend a night.

Overnight in Rabat

Day 2: Rabat - ChefChaouen

Have breakfast at your hotel, meet with your tour guide and he will accompany you around the capital city of Morocco. The guided tour we offer in Rabat is aimed at revealing the history of Rabat. The places to be visited will include Royal Palace, Chellah, Hassan Tower, and Kasbah Oudaya.

have some time after that to walk around these souks and bazaars located within an ancient medina in Rabat filled with different goods such as old and new types by Moroccan styles meeting some traditional shoes made from leather beside them.

Then, Continue to “Café Maure” on the bank of river Bouregreg, to enjoy a Moroccan mint tea (optional) alongside some Moroccan goodies like Kaab Ghazal and Ghariba. After the tour, you will be taking the road and saying goodbye to Rabat and Hello to Chefchaouen.

Overnight in Chefchaouen

Meals: Breakfast, Tea break

Day 3: ChefChaouen - Fez

Take off after breakfast on your tour which includes going to Kasbah Ali Ben Rachid, Plaza Uta el-Hammam, and then touring around this lovely city. Chefchaouen is the “Blue Pearl” of Morocco. This name has come as a result of the blue color that is used by all its inhabitants to paint houses. The color spread on the city makes it look absolutely charming giving it feelings resembling those of relief, coziness, and peace.

End the day at Fez, The Capital of Science and Knowledge is where you are headed next before passing through Volubilis where Volubilis and Meknes towns lie. In the Imperial City of Meknes, you will resume after departure from Volubilis. More specifically, The city was founded by Moulay Ismail and planned as the ‘Versailles of Morocco.’ Simpler communication effectively, avoiding techno-jargon in its present state will achieve a more understandable veracious text that increases the readability of the above passage by changing approximately 40% of its complex phrases into everyday language.

Day 4: Fez Exploration Day

Have your breakfast at the hotel. After that, Visit the Royal Palace of Fez (Dar al-Makhzen) and explore its magnificent gates and architecture. Then, Explore the Mellah (Jewish Quarter) with its historic synagogues and unique architecture.

Our tour guide will take you to major areas such as Bou-Inania and Attarin Medersa, the tanneries, Ess-Seffarine Square, Moulay Idris's tomb, El-Nejjarine Square, and the cabinet makers' souk as well as the Hebrew district 'Mellah'.

You will have a pottery workshop with a pottery master as part of your itinerary in order to get a complete Moroccan feel. Following lunch in a nearby restaurant, the choice is yours; return to your hotel or have a walk on your own in the maze of narrow streets in the old town. Fez is a rich city; hence we encourage you to take your time and explore it throughout the day.

Day 5: Fez - Ifrane - Midelt - Erfoud - Merzouga

We are going to Ifran and Midelt to Erfoud after breakfast. Erfoud will be the entranceway to the great Sahara Desert in Morocco. Archeologists have discovered fossils there which are hundreds of years old.

When you arrive at Erfoud, drive all over the barren sand dunes through the lifetime adventurous drive in 4-wheel vehicles. Make sure you experience a stunning sunset on your way to the camp at Merzouga.

Overnight in Merzouga

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 6: Merzouga - Erfoud - Ouarzazate

in the morning, After breakfast. A camel should be riding early enough to watch the sunrise over the dunes. Next; tour from Erfoud to Ouarzazate with a driver who speaks English today.

Todra Gorge is an area worth visiting during the tour. They are found at a distance of 110 km(65 miles) westwards from Ouarzazate in the southwest direction below Tinerhir. After taking some beautiful pictures, continue driving towards Ouarzazate. Furthermore, you will visit Skoura an amazing oasis in Morocco just before it."

Day 7: Ouarzazate - Ait Ben Haddou - Marrakech

Check out from your hotel in Ouarzazate. Along the way, you will drive through scenic views of the Atlas Mountains towards Ait Ben Haddou. At that place, have the chance to visit the Atlas Studios home of some

of the world's most loved films and series like The Mummy, Gladiator, Asterix, Obelix, and of course Game of Thrones. So make the best of it.

While heading to Marrakech, explore the breathtaking Tizi n'Tichka mountain pass. Once you reach Marrakech check in at the hotel. In Marrakech, dinner shall be served at any local restaurant as you experience the lively nightlife and busy city.

Day 8: Marrakech Tour

Today you will get the chance to wake up and live in Marrakech, a dream of many, so be sure to make the best of it. After your breakfast, our local guide and the driver guide will be waiting for you to start a guided city tour of "Ochre City". We will visit first in the morning the Majorelle Garden which was named after the French painter, Jacques Majorelle who dedicated a lot of effort and passion to this art piece.

After Majorelle, continue to Menara and though the name in Arabic translates to "lighthouse", it is actually a pavilion with a basin and a garden of orchards and olive groves. We will be heading afterward to the Koutoubia Mosque and through the Jewish quarter called Mallah.

After lunch at a local restaurant, finish your visit with a carriage ride or "Koutchi" to Jemaa El Fnaa.

Overnight in Marrakech

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 9: Marrakech - Casablanca

Have breakfast at your hotel before heading to Casablanca. Once in Casablanca, you will be joined by your local guide for a visit to the Hassan II Mosque, an Architectural masterpiece overlooking the Atlantic coast of Casablanca.

Continue afterward for a tour of the city and its corniche, the Habous quarters, and the Royal Palace (exterior visit).
