The Edge of the World, also known as Jebel Fihrayn, is a remarkable geological marvel nestled in the rocky desert northwest of Riyadh. This geological wonder is part of the extensive Tuwaiq Escarpment, dropping down 1,000 feet into an ancient ocean bed.
