Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon arrival, our tour manager will facilitate a swift check-in and review your [Cairo day tour](#) itinerary to confirm that all pick-up times are convenient. Enjoy an overnight stay at your Cairo hotel.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, and Old Cairo

After breakfast, meet your English-speaking guide at the hotel to begin your exploration of the Giza Pyramids. Visit the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, King Chephren's Middle Pyramid, and King Mycerinus's Pyramid. You'll also see the Valley Temple of King Chephren and the Great Sphinx. Next, head to the [Egyptian Museum](#), home to an extensive collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts, including the treasures of Tutankhamun.

Continue your tour in [Coptic Cairo](#), visiting the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, [the Hanging Church](#), Abu Serga Church, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Enjoy lunch at a quality Egyptian restaurant before exploring [Islamic Cairo](#), including its famous mosques and the bustling [Khan El Khalili bazaar](#). Return to your hotel for the night.

Day 3: Luxor's East Bank

Day 4: Luxor's West Bank and Edfu

After breakfast on the cruise, your guide will take you to the West Bank to see [the Colossi of Memnon](#), the Valley of the Kings, and [Queen Hatshepsut's Temple](#). After lunch, sail towards Edfu. Enjoy an evening buffet dinner, followed by musical shows and belly-dancing entertainment. Optional hot-air balloon rides over Luxor offer stunning views of the ancient sites and the Nile River. Overnight on the Nile cruise.

Day 5: Edfu and Komombo

Begin your day with breakfast on the cruise before visiting the [Temple of Edfu](#), dedicated to the falcon god Horus. Continue sailing to [Kom Ombo](#) to see the dual temples dedicated to Sobek and Haroeris. Lunch is served on board as you sail towards Aswan. Enjoy dinner and a Nubian show in the evening, followed by an overnight stay on the cruise.

After breakfast, explore [Aswan's day tour](#) highlights, including the [High Dam](#) and the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), likely commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut. Return to the cruise for dinner and an overnight stay.
