### Day 1: East Bank Exploration

## Day 2: Explore the West Bank

Continue to the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, also known as the Temple of Deir el-Bahari, and admire the impressive <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. After your tour, return to the cruise for lunch as you set sail for Edfu.

Enjoy dinner on board and spend the night docked in Edfu.

### Day 3: Visit Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

Begin your day with a fresh breakfast aboard the cruise. Your day's exploration starts at <u>Edfu Temple</u>, dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god of protection and kingship. After your visit, the cruise will continue its journey toward the <u>Aswan day tour</u>, with a stop in the ancient town of <u>Kom Ombo</u>. Here, your Egyptologist guide will lead you through the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom Ombo, which honors the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris. Lunch will be served as you sail, and in the evening, enjoy dinner on board followed by a Nubian cultural show. Overnight in Aswan. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

#### Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Start your day with a buffet breakfast on the cruise, followed by a visit to some of Aswan's most notable sites. Begin with the impressive Aswan High Dam, a modern marvel that controls the Nile's flow and generates electricity. Next, visit the <a href="Unfinished Obelisk">Unfinished Obelisk</a>, an enormous granite monument that was never completed, likely intended for Queen Hatshepsut. Finally, explore the beautiful <a href="Philae Temple">Philae Temple</a>, dedicated to the goddess Isis, built in the elegant Greco-Roman style. Return to the cruise for a leisurely lunch and enjoy your final dinner on board as you spend the night in Aswan.

# Day 5: Disembarkation from Nile Cruise

After a final breakfast on board, you may choose to take an optional excursion to the <u>Abu Simbel temples</u>, built by Ramses II for himself and his queen, Nefertari.
