# Day 1: Cairo - Alamein - Siwa

At 6:00 AM, your Cairo Top Tours professional tour leader will meet you at your hotel to begin your exciting Egypt Desert Safari to Siwa Oasis. Your journey starts with an El Alamein tour, where you'll visit the World War II Cemeteries, paying homage to the soldiers who fought and sacrificed their lives. Managed by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission, these cemeteries honor the men and women from Commonwealth nations who served during the war. You will also explore the site of the historic battle and visit the El Alamein World War II Museum, offering insight into this significant chapter of history.

Afterward, continue your journey to the stunning bay of <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> on Egypt's North Coast. Here, you'll savor a delicious seafood lunch by the crystal-clear waters before embarking on the final leg of your drive to Siwa, which takes around six hours from El Alamein.

Upon arrival in Siwa, relax with a rejuvenating swim in one of the natural hot water springs, perfect for unwinding after your day of travel. End your day with an overnight stay at a charming Eco-lodge in <u>Siwa</u>, where you'll experience a peaceful night in the heart of the desert.

## Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

After breakfast, your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari adventure continues with a visit to the fascinating ruins of the old town of Siwa, known as Shali. Despite its partial decay, the remnants of this ancient town offer a glimpse into Siwa's rich history. Next, you will be transferred to the Temple of Alexander the Great, also called the Temple of the Oracle, located in the ancient village of Aghurmi. Dating back to the 26th dynasty, this temple played a significant role in ancient Egypt's history and was believed to be a site where Alexander the Great sought guidance.

Your tour then takes you to the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> at Um Ubeyda, a sacred site dedicated to the god Amun and his divine triad. Afterward, experience Siwa's unique heritage by visiting the <u>Siwa House Museum</u>, where you'll learn about the rich culture and customs of the local Bedouin tribes.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at Abdo Restaurant in the bustling square of the oasis, with views of the historic Shali Fortress.

In the afternoon, unwind at <u>Cleopatra's Spring</u> (Ein Guba) for a refreshing dip in the crystal-clear waters of this natural spring. Your day concludes with a magical sunset view on Fitnas Island, offering a serene and unforgettable experience as you watch the sun sink over the desert horizon.

## Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Start your day with an organic breakfast at the eco-lodge, setting the tone for an exciting day of adventure. Your journey through the <u>Great Sand Sea</u> begins with a visit to Maraki village, where you'll explore an extraordinary archaeological site at the majestic Siwa Mountain. Here, you'll have the opportunity to see the first human footprint ever discovered, adding historical depth to your desert safari.

Next, you'll visit one of the most stunning sights in the Great Sand Sea: a beautiful lake located in the heart of the desert. The serene atmosphere offers a perfect opportunity for birdwatching, and if you're lucky, you might catch a glimpse of flamingos. Feel free to take a refreshing swim in the cold, clear waters, allowing yourself to fully immerse in the tranquility of the desert.

For thrill-seekers, the adventure continues with an exhilarating sandboarding experience. Glide down the massive dunes of the Great Sand Sea, and with the right wax, enjoy a thrilling ride down the soft sands. Afterward, relax and wash off the desert dust with a dip in the famous hot spring, <u>Bir Wahid</u>. Its warm, 40°C waters provide a soothing retreat to relax your muscles.

Here, you'll explore the fascinating tombs of Siwa's rulers from the 26th Dynasty, including the Tomb of Si Amon and the Crocodile Tomb.

Next, you will head to the Bedouin village of Abu Ali, where you'll experience the simple yet captivating Bedouin lifestyle. Take the opportunity to visit their one-class school and explore other interesting features of their daily life. As part of this cultural immersion, you'll visit the site believed to be the Tomb of Alexander the Great, a place that adds a layer of historical mystique to your journey.

Afterward, return to Siwa to visit <u>Dakrour Mountain</u>, a site of great cultural importance for the Siwan people. It is here that they celebrate the annual Tourism Festival of El Syaha, held during the first full moon of October. The festival is a time of unity and tradition for the Siwan community, and you'll learn about its significance while enjoying the stunning views from the mountain.

As the day winds down, you'll return to your hotel for a relaxing evening and overnight stay in Siwa.
