## Day 2: The 18th Dynasty - Beit El Wali

The first stop is the <u>Kalabsha Temple</u>, which was built during the <u>18th Dynasty</u> and was devoted to the gods <u>Amun-Re</u> and <u>Khnum</u>. It was relocated in the 1960s to prevent its submerging by the resultant water of the Aswan High Dam.

Fascinating stories from your guide about the rich history and artistry involved in the construction will intrigue you. Next is the <u>Beit El Wali</u>, an equally stunning example of architectural genius from that age, entirely dedicated to victories that Ramses II won and the gods he favored.

You will have lunch at a restaurant where you can enjoy the fortes of the region. Immediately after lunch, visit the <u>Temple of Abu Simbel</u> UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most magnificent tributes that was given to Ramses II. The tour will end in the picturesque <u>Wadi El Sebou</u>, a highly scenic place with great landscapes and historical interest. You will have dinner on board and round off this day with an excellent ending to such an enriching experience.

## Day 3: Amada Temple - Nubian culture

Enjoy your delicious breakfast on board and start another great day with **Egypt Day Tours**. Having your breakfast, start an amazing tour with your professional guide and get ready to behold the magnificent attractions of Nubia. First, head to **Wadi El Sebou** or the real oasis which is highly known for its rock engravings and ruins. Hewn out of the mountain during the time of Pharaoh Ramses II, it consists of two temples with stunning carvings carved directly into the rock walls. They are committed to Ramses II and his queen, Nefertari, to mark her victory at the Battle of Kadesh.
