Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival and Accommodation in Cairo

At <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you and hold a sign with your name on it. After that, you'll travel in a private, air-conditioned car to your accommodation in Giza.

Our staff will help you check in easily and get settled into your accommodation at the hotel. To find out the exact timings of pick-up, consult your Egypt Classic Tours schedule. Take advantage of a welcome drink on

Day 2: Exploring the Pyramids

Breakfast in the Cairo Hotel—the great beginning of the day and a great start to exploring Egypt. Your professional tour guide is ready to take you and guide you throughout your Giza Pyramids tour. Go to see the Great Pyramids of Cheops as you may ascend or merely view the spectacle. Go on to the Pyramid of King Chephren and the Great Sphynx.

Visit the little pyramids, of which the Great Pyramid of King Mycerinus is the largest, and if it is possible, take an optional camel ride for a lovely feeling and an extraordinary picture. Then you should go to <u>Valley Temple</u>, which was used for rituals, and then go to Memphis for the Museum of Open Air, which displays many reminders of ancient Egypt, particularly the capital city. Do not miss at <u>Saqqara</u> the first pyramid the <u>Step Pyramid</u> by Imhotep. Join the pyramid of Teti, where you will see the hieroglyphs and a Mastaba tomb that has lively scenes. In the evening, after a local lunch in the Saqqara area, get back to your hotel in Giza.

Meals: breakfast and lunch.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum and Cairo Exploration

After breakfast, continue your tour with a visit to the Egyptian Museum, renowned for its vast collection of Egyptian artifacts, including the famous treasures of Tutankhamun. Next, explore the Citadel of Saladin, once the administrative center of Egypt, and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, an exquisite example of Ottoman architecture. Discover Islamic Cairo's historic mosques and towers. In Coptic Cairo, visit the Roman fortress of Babylon and the Hanging Church, also known as Al Mualaka, situated atop the fortress. Explore the Church of St. Sergius, built over the site where the Holy Family is believed to have stayed, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue, traditionally located where baby Moses was found. Enjoy lunch before wandering through the bustling Khan El Khalili bazaar, with its medieval streets and ancient gates. Return to your Cairo hotel for the night.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

Day 4: Alexandria Day Trip

After breakfast, embark on a day trip to Alexandria with your knowledgeable English-speaking Egyptologist guide. Enjoy a brief stop along the way before arriving in Alexandria, the Mediterranean city founded by Alexander. Visit Pompey's Pillar, erected in 297 B.C. to commemorate the triumph of Roman Emperor Diocletian, and explore the Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa, one of the largest Roman cemeteries. Continue to the Citadel of Qaitbay, where you can enjoy views of the coastline and the historic site of the Lighthouse of Alexandria. Tour the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a modern library and cultural center inspired by the ancient Library of Alexandria, founded by Ptolemy I in the early 3rd century B.C. Enjoy a lunch of fresh seafood before returning to your Cairo hotel. Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

Day 5: Leaving

Enjoy your final breakfast as part of your <u>Egypt classic tour</u>. After checking out, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will transfer you to Cairo International Airport for your departure.
