Itinerary

The first day: Arrival in Cairo

So that after that you will be driven to the hotel in either Giza or Cairo. Also, we will assist you with an efficient check-in at the hotel once you have arrived and discuss the various Egypt Day Tours you had planned to help you cross-check all your pick-up times for all the tours in and out of Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids & Sphinx and Cairo attractions

Make the most of your one-day buffet breakfast at the hotel serving delectable international and Egyptian cuisine, and then it will be your turn to be escorted by your English-speaking tour guide to the <u>Giza Plateau</u>; bring the reality of your dreams to life. See the Great Giza and the Pyramid of the famous King Cheops.

Your lunch will be served in a high-quality restaurant in Cairo. You will be driving to <u>Islamic Cairo</u> to spend time in the market and see the real life in Egypt and also try the traditional tea-mint in El Fishawy or Layaly Al-Hussein, Cairo's oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili. Back again to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.

After breakfast, your tour begins with a visit to the Egyptian Museum, home to an extensive collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts, including the treasures of King Tutankhamun. Following that, you'll head to Coptic Cairo to explore its rich Christian heritage. Visit the old Roman fortress of Babylon, built by Emperor Trajan in the 1st century, and the famous Hanging Church, constructed above the fortress's towers.

You'll then take a walk through the streets of Old Cairo, accompanied by your private guide, to visit the Church of St. Sergius, where the Holy Family is believed to have stayed for three months. The last stop in Old Cairo will be the Ben Ezra Synagogue, one of the oldest Jewish synagogues in the city.

Day 3: Journey from Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, check out and prepare for your trip to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>. Meet your expert guide from Cairo Top Tours and travel in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle for approximately four hours. Upon arriving at the oasis, your first stop will be the Valley of the <u>Golden Mummies</u>, an incredible archaeological discovery made by chance, revealing thousands of gold-covered mummies from the Roman era. Then, you'll visit the Tombs of the Nobles, who ruled the oasis during the Pharaonic era, followed by a stop at the Temple of Alexander the Great, a historical site discovered by Egyptian archaeologists, although partially damaged due to natural causes. You'll also explore the Temple of Ein El Meffetla, once considered the center of the ancient city of Al Qasr.

After a delightful lunch at the oasis, check into your hotel and spend a leisurely afternoon, perhaps enjoying a relaxing soak in the hot springs. Before sunset, you'll explore the oasis on foot, meet locals, and learn about their customs. Your day ends with a climb up the <u>Black Mountain</u> to visit the ruins of the English House, offering a breathtaking view of the oasis during sunset, an experience that's well worth the effort.

The day culminates at the White Desert, a stunning area featuring chalk formations shaped by annual sandstorms, resembling art sculptures. You'll camp overnight in the White Desert, enjoying a magnificent sunset and a freshly cooked Bedouin dinner, with a chance to spot the elusive desert fox.
