Itinerary

Day 1: Travel to Cairo, check in, and spend the night

Subsequently, visiting <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, we start with the Babylonian Roman fortress and the suspended church above the towers of the fortress. You will also see the Church of Abu Serga and <u>the Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, an old Jewish synagogue in old Cairo.

Savor lunch in a superior restaurant in Egypt, proceed with the Islamic Cairo Tour to visit both mosques that were constructed during the period of Islamic dominance and Khan El Khalili, which is Cairo's old spice bazaar, and then go back to the hotel.
