Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor East Bank Tour

Regardless of the time of your flight, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at the <u>Luxor International Airport</u> to transport you to your cruise. After being driven to your hotel, a professional tour leader will help you with the check-in process.

You will have a delicious lunch. You will see the magnificent Temple of Luxor. After that, visit the <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which was built as an homage to God Amon, his wife <u>Mut</u>, and their son Khonsu. This is one of history's biggest displays of adoration. You will be transferred back to the cruise, where you can eat a delicious dinner and relax.

Meals: Lunch and dinner

Day 2: Tour to the Valley of the Kings, the Queen Hatshepsut temple and the Colossi of Memnon

You will start your tour with breakfast on the cruise and then embark on a wonderful tour of Luxor's holy sites, taking in the West Bank of Luxor and the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>. You will go to the Queen Hatshepsut shrine at Deir El Bahari after the picturesque trip. This temple is entirely engraved into the rock, and it is considered to be one of the most amazing examples of ancient Egyptian artifacts. You will see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> in the kingdom of King Amenhotep III. Your lunch will be served on the cruise. You then cruise to Esna to observe. After sailing and arriving at <u>Edfu</u>, you can unwind for a while.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

We will pick you up after breakfast to have a tour of the <u>Edfu</u> Horus Temple, where you can see the royal temple, which was dedicated to Horus. This temple is often regarded as the best-maintained temple in Egypt. According to Egyptian mythology, this is the place where the falcon-headed god Horus kills Seth as retaliation for the death of <u>Osiris</u>, his father. You will travel to the <u>Kom Ombo</u> <u>Temple</u> to see the unique temple, which was dedicated to the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u>. Lunch will then be served on board the cruise. Following supper, you sail to Aswan and spend the rest of the evening on

board. Get some sleep.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 4: Tour to Philae Temple - Sail to Aswan

Your tour guide will pick you up after breakfast to take you to beautiful Agilika Island. After a delicious lunch, you'll visit the <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was built during the Greco-Roman era and honors the <u>goddess Isis</u>, the mother of the god Horus. You will be dropped off at your Nile cruise so you can get some rest.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 5: Disembarkation

On the last day, you will eat your breakfast and take some time to enjoy the warm weather before being escorted to the <u>Aswan Airport</u> to catch your flight back to your home.
