Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

A tour manager from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at the Aswan airport and drive you to the MS Al Jamila Nile cruise, which is your Egypt Nile River cruise.

The cruise ship offers lunch service. The southernmost city in Egypt, Aswan, is where you should begin your visits. Nearly 1,000 kilometers from Cairo, it is situated in the first Nile Falls. Enjoy your Aswan day trips to [the High Dam](#), which controls the flow of the river to provide energy to the majority of Egypt's villages for

the first time. This project is very significant in modern history, on par with the Suez Canal.

You will then be taken to witness the relocated Temple of Philae, which was constructed in the Greco-Roman style to honor the [Goddess Isis](#). You will study the narrative of Isis and Horus and comprehend that early Christians attempted to elevate the pagan image from their newly claimed churches, causing harm to some of the ancient Egyptian gods' statues. Continue your Aswan excursions to the granite quarries to witness the Queen Hatshepsut Unfinished Obelisk.

After we've concluded our [Egypt Day Trips](#), head back to the vessel that will be setting sail. Enjoy your afternoon tea, the captain's welcome cocktail will be served later, and you will have a magnificent dinner on board your Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor in the evening. As you spend the night on your Nile cruise ship in Aswan, take in the Nubian Show.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on board the cruise ship on day two before setting out for Kom Ombo to see the majestic temple there built to honor the two gods Sobek and Haeroris [Kom Ombo temple](#). Then, because the locals disliked having a deity that stood for evil, they added another deity to the cult: Haroeris (Horus the Elder). Following your lunch on board the Nile cruise ship, you will then set sail for Edfu where you will visit the revered temple of Horus the falcon, who avenged his father's death at the hands of his uncle. After your two-hour tour of the [Edfu Temple](#), you'll head back to the Nile cruise to get ready for dinner while taking in the scenery.

After that, you'll set sail for Esna and take in a Galabeya Party in Egypt.

Stay the night in Esna.

Day 3: Luxor West Bank Tours

Enjoy your breakfast as you cruise to Luxor, at which point you will begin Luxor day tours, specifically Luxor West Bank Tours to the [Valley of the Kings in Luxor](#) and Queens, which was a section of the ancient city of Thebes and served as the final resting place for nearly all of the pharaohs of the eighth, ninth, and twentieth ruling families of the new kingdom in ancient Egypt. Then, continue your Luxor excursions to see the El-Dei temple, which is also known as the temple. After enjoying the weather and the vista, you will return to the cruise ship and eat lunch there. After that, you will enjoy afternoon tea there before having dinner on board the boat and witnessing a belly dance performance.

Day 4: Disembarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

After enjoying your final wonderful breakfast and the view of the Nile, disembark from your leisurely Egypt trip. A representative from Cairo Top Tours will pick you up from your Nile River Cruise and take you on an east-bank tour of Luxor's [Karnak Temple](#). The hypostyle hall is the most impressive part of the temple, measuring more than 5,000 square meters and containing 134 columns, 12 of which are wider than the others, and raised the roof, which is now destroyed, to a height of 23 meters. & [Luxor Temple](#), which is situated almost three kilometers away from Karnak Temple, The Avenue of the Sphinxes, one of ancient Egypt's most ambitious construction endeavors, united the two. You will be transferred to the airport or train station for your last departure after concluding the Luxor Sightseeing excursions.
