Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

Anywhere in Luxor, our representative will meet you and transport you in an air-conditioned vehicle to the Steamship Sudan Nile Cruise for embarkation and a lunch buffet. The temple of Amun, who was the father of the gods in ancient Egyptian mythology, lies inside the spectacular [Karnak Temple](#) Complex, which was

erected by numerous Kings and rulers of ancient Egypt. You'll be astounded by how enormous the temple is, so it's no wonder! From the middle kingdom to the Ptolemaic dynasty, it underwent extensive construction and development. You will next go on to the [Luxor Temple](#), which was constructed by Amenophis III but for which [Ramses II](#) is mostly responsible.

Food: Lunch and Dinner

Day 2: Valley of the Kings - Sail to Esna / Edfu

After breakfast today, you'll go to the [Valley of the Kings](#), a Theban necropolis from the [New Kingdom](#) where the pharaohs embellished their tombs to seem like works of art. You will visit tombs like Ramses VI's, which is one of the largest and best preserved tombs in the region. Before eating lunch and traveling to Esna towards [Edfu](#) and spending the night on board, have a look at the fabled Deir el-Madina, the valley of the workers who were in charge of painting the tombs.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

A morning tour to the Temple of Edfu, which was constructed in the 3rd century B.C. Ptolemaic Dynasty and dedicated to the [gods Horus](#) and the goddess of motherhood, [Hathor](#). It is one of the best-preserved structures in Egyptian history. Once again, you will be sailing to Kom Ombo for a spectacular sunset. Visit the [Kom Ombo Temple](#), a singular complex dedicated to the two great deities Sobek and Haroeris. Nothing can match its majesty.

Day 4: Sail to Aswan - Philae Temple

After breakfast, continue floating the Nile River to Aswan to see the lovely islands that line it, including the Elephantine Island, which served as a commerce hub for the Nubian civilization and was distinguished by its fertile land. You will enjoy your lunch and have the opportunity to see the lovely [Sound and Light Show in the Philae Temple](#) (optional excursion) before dinner and overnight. The Temple of Philae is the home for the worship of the wife of God Osiris, [Goddess Isis](#), Goddess of Magic, and the hero in the well-known myth against the evil God Seth according to ancient Egyptian religion.
