Itinerary

Day 1: Luxor East Bank

Our agent will pick you up from the Luxor Airport or train station and transfer you in a private car to your Nile Cruise. In the afternoon, you will visit the East Bank of Luxor, which includes the complex of the Karnak Temple, the biggest construction that was ever constructed in human history. The main structure is the god Amun Ra since it was regarded as the abode of God on earth. The earliest buildings date back to the

Middle Kingdom, while other records mention them being as old as the third dynasty.

The Temple of Luxor, which was started by one of the 12th dynasty monarchs and finished by the famous pharaoh <u>Ramses II</u> will be the next stop for you. This temple was located in the center of ancient Thebes and was devoted to the chief/principal god Amun Re. You will be transferred back to your ship to take some rest when your <u>Egypt day trip</u> is over. The personnel will run a folkloric Egyptian entertainment at night.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank - Sail to Edfu

On the Nile cruise, breakfast. Then you'll begin your enchanted tour of Thebes, the sacred region, by seeing the west bank of Luxor and the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, which is thought to be the royal cemetery of the Theban kings and rulers of ancient Egypt and the location where our Pharaohs were interred. You will next go to Deir El Bahari to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut.

Because it was entirely carved into the mountain, this temple is regarded as one of the most beautiful specimens of ancient Egyptian architecture. You will see the Colossi of Memnon, which belonged to king <u>Amenhotep III</u>, at the conclusion of the journey. You will then head back to your ship to eat lunch. Free time in the afternoon. Dinner and a night's sleep aboard the ship.

Included meals include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: Edfu-Kom Ombo-Sail to Aswan

Onboard your Nile cruise, and breakfast. The voyage to the country of mysteries will then be mysterious, led by your tour guide. The Temple of Horus at <u>Edfu</u>, which is regarded as one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, is the first stop on this guided tour today. It is one of the most beautiful temples in all of Egypt. You will then return to your ship after that. While traveling to Kom Ombo, lunch will be served on board.

You will move on to explore the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u> in the afternoon, which is where the two gods Sobek and Haroeris were once worshipped. Return to your ship and have a lunch break. Enjoy the sun terrace while observing the great river Nile's distinctive landscape. The development and flourishing of the ancient Egyptian civilization took place on its banks.

During the voyage to Aswan, a dinner will be provided on board. Arrives in Aswan in the late evening; stays the night.

Day 4: Aswan City Tour

There will be breakfast provided on your ship. Later, you will go with your Egyptologist tour guide to explore the magnificent city of Aswan, including The <u>High Dam</u>, which was built in 1960 AD to defend Egypt from the Nile flood by Egyptian president Gamal Abdel Nasser. After that, you can take pleasure in motorboating along the Nile River until you get to Agilika Island, where you can explore the Temple of Philae, which was built during the Greco-Roman era and honors the goddess Isis (mother of the god Horus). The Unfinished Obelisk, a magnificent site in Aswan formed of red granite and dedicated to the god Amun

Ra, will be the last place you are taken.

You will return to your ship after your day trip is over. On board, lunch will be provided. On board, afternoon tea will be provided. free to enjoy oneself at night. Aswan's dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5: Disembarkation from cruise - Departure to Cairo

After breakfast, check out. Following that, our agent will drive you to the <u>Aswan airport</u>/train station so you can catch your trip to Cairo.
