## Day 1: Check-in-High Dam-Philae Temple

When you arrive at <u>Aswan airport</u>, our tour guide will meet you there and help you to the MS Blue Shadow Nile cruise to check in and start your incredible Aswan day tour to see the Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, as well as other incredible Aswan attractions.

Since the High Dam has significantly improved storage capacity, it is now possible to manage floods and store water for release over several years. It was constructed in 1960 to protect Egypt from the yearly floods, and it includes 18 times as much materials as the Giza Pyramids, then proceed to the Temple of Philae, one of the four locations where the myth of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. This <u>Greco-Roman-</u>style temple was built and dedicated to the worship of the Goddess Isis. You should return to your Egypt Nile River Cruise for lunch and dinner.

### Day 2: Kom Ombo Temple - Edfu Temple

After serving up a delectable breakfast on board your deluxe Egypt Nile River Cruise, we'll head to Kom Ombo to carry on with our Blue Shadow Nile Cruise. After that, you will continue sailing to the next port of call to visit Horus Temple, also known as <u>Edfu</u> Temple.<u>God Horus</u> was the ancient Egyptian god of the sky and the defender of monarchy. He was the son of Isis and Osiris, and was depicted as having a man's body and a hawk's head. Dinner and lunch will be served on the cruise ship.

## Day 3: Luxor Tours

After breakfast on board the Aswan to Luxor Nile River Cruise, get ready to sail to Esna and then Luxor to begin your Egypt Day trips, especially Luxor day tour to the East and the West Bank. Here, the Kings built their tombs very far away from the tomb thieves, and today, more than 60 tombs carved into the rocks have been discovered. Next, you will visit the <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> Temple, also known as the Temple of Deir El Bahari, which was the Continue your Luxor excursions to see one of Egypt's most amazing structures, the <u>Karnak Temple</u> structures, which is also Egypt's largest temple and was constructed over the course of 2000 years from a little shrine during the <u>New Kingdom</u> to a massive temple that occupies a sizable area.
