Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Your arrival will be greeted and assisted by our professional tour manager, after which you will board MY Alexander the Great Nile Cruise and check in before lunch.

After enjoying your lunch on board your luxury Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor, you will be accompanied on an Aswan day trip to the High Dam. View <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was actually one of the last locations where the ancient Egyptian religion of <u>goddess Isis</u> was practiced after the spread of Christianity in Egypt, and sail on the Nile by motorboat, which is a new and exciting experience. At the time of its construction, <u>the High Dam</u> was responsible for about 50% of the electricity production in Egypt Continue your Aswan excursions to the granite quarries to witness the <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> Unfinished Obelisk, following which you'll enjoy afternoon tea and the Captain's Welcome Cocktail. A tasty lunch will be served on the cruise ship while you take in a Nubian performance.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

You will enjoy your breakfast on the cruise ship, then you will sail to <u>Kom Ombo temple</u> to begin your second <u>Egypt Day Trips</u> by visiting the temple shared by two gods, Sobek and Horus. You will then continue to sail to <u>Edfu</u>, where you will enjoy your lunch on the Nile cruise ship before being taken to see the Edfu Temple, which was constructed for the worship of God Horus, the son of Osiris and Isis and one of the most powerful and significant gods in ancient Egypt Following the tour of Edfu, you will enjoy a quiet lunch while taking in the scenery. The gods of ancient Egypt, as described in ancient Egyptian religion. After that, you set out on Esna to take part in an exotic Galapagos Party.

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

After enjoying your breakfast on board, you will proceed to sail to Luxor through Esna. Following lunch on the cruise ship, you will enjoy a relaxing afternoon tea before beginning Luxor activities.

During your Luxor day tours, you will be escorted to the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which is a sizable Ancient Egyptian temple complex built by the New Kingdom monarchs and is typically visited during the Luxor East Bank Tours in the city now known as Luxor (formerly Thebes) concerning 1400 B.C. Continue to <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which is also referred to as "the southern sanctuary" in ancient Egyptian. You'll appreciate witnessing a belly dance performance while eating supper on the cruise ship.

Afternoon in Luxor

Day 4: Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

After eating breakfast on the cruise ship, you will disembark and continue your Luxor sightseeing excursions by seeing the <u>Valley of the Kings in Luxor</u>, one of the must-see locations on any trip to Egypt. If pressed, we would name Thutmose III, Ramses IX, Siptah, and Ramses IV as our top four favorite tombs. Your next stop is the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (El-Deir El-Bahari Temple), which was one of the most powerful royal tombs in the ancient Egyptian new kingdom at the height of its civilization.

Once everything is over, one of our agents will take you to the Luxor Airport or train station.
