Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan Tour

After welcoming you and your assistance, our representative will take you to the board in time for lunch. After a delicious lunch on the MS Royal Princess Nile Cruise, you will be taken to Aswan to start your Egypt Day Tours with a visit to the famous [high dam](#). This impressive structure is about 4,000 meters long and 980

meters wide at the base, and it contains 43,000,000 cubic meters of materials.

During the excursions in Aswan, you will be taken to the granite quarries where the ancient Egyptians obtained the necessary stone blocks for the construction of the impressive pyramids and temples. You will also see the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), which is thought to have been carved during the reign of the illustrious and strong [Queen Hatshepsut](#) during the history of the New Kingdom in ancient Egypt.

After seeing one of the architectural wonders of ancient Egypt, such as the Temple of Philae or the [Goddess Isis Temple](#), your driver, and guide will take you back to Aswan for a full day of excursions before sailing on the Nile and greeting you with the Captain's Welcome Cocktail.

You will watch an incredible Nubian show while eating dinner on your Egypt Nile River cruise.

You'll stay the night in Aswan.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

After eating breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, you will go on a tour to Kom Ombo and [Edfu](#). Kom Ombo is a curious double temple located in the village of Kom Ombo in the Aswan Governorate of Upper Egypt. It was built between 180 and 47 BC, during the Ptolemaic era. Following exploring the amazing temple shared by the crocodile-shaped [god Sobek](#) and Haroeris, known as the [Kom Ombo temple](#), some alterations to it were eventually built during the Roman era. You will then cruise to Edfu following that you will eat lunch while traveling on your luxury Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor, after that, you will be taken to see the Edfu Temple, which was constructed between 237 and 57 B.C. during Ptolemaic era.

Horus, the god with a falcon on his head, was worshipped in the temple of Edfu. You will have dinner on board the cruise ship before setting sail for Esna to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party. The "Galabeya" is a type of clothing in Egypt that is a one-piece long dress for men and women. The Ancient Egyptians believed that the temple was built on the site where the great myth between the gods Horus and Seth took place.

You'll stay the night in Esna.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

Your third day will begin with breakfast on board the Nile cruise ship, followed by a trip to Luxor via the Esna lock to enjoy [Luxor East Bank Tours](#), lunch on board the Nile cruise ship from Aswan to Luxor, some downtime for afternoon tea, and then Luxor day tours to see the Luxor Temple.

The third courtyard in your Egypt day trips, which was constructed during the rule of the renowned architect and military conqueror Amenophis, and the outer courtyard, which were both constructed during the nineteenth dynasty, are referred to as Ramesses II's courtyards. You will see [Karnak Temple](#) after having dinner and taking part in a belly dancing show on board the 4-Day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor. It measures 57 meters (188 feet) long and 51 meters (168 feet) wide.

You'll stay the night in Luxor.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 4: Luxor West Bank Tours - Disembarkation

You will begin by eating breakfast on board the cruise ship, and then being transferred to begin the Luxor West Bank Tours. Once there, you will visit the magnificent Temple of [Queen Hatshepsut](#) (El-Deir El-Bahari Temple) and choose three tombs to see from the inside in the [Valley of the Kings in Luxor](#). The first undiscovered tomb following the discoveries of Queen Hatshepsut's Temple and Tutankhamun's Tomb (El-Deir El-Bahari).

Finally, check out the Egypt Nile River Cruise.
