<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Embarkation-Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

You will be greeted and helped by the tour manager of Cairo Top Tours before being transferred to board the MS Tulip Nile Cruise, where you may eat lunch while taking in the breathtaking views of the Nile River. The High Dam of Aswan, which was finished in 1971, and the enormous lake beyond, which was named after the former Egyptian President Gamal Abdel Nasser and filled in in 1979, will be our first stop on Aswan day tours. From there, we'll continue our Egypt Day Trips in Aswan to the Temple of Philae, which gained notoriety during the Ptolemaic Dynasty as the primary site of worship for the Goddess Isis, After your Aswan excursions are through, you'll take a speedboat trip along the Nile before continuing with your enjoyable dinner and a Nubian oriental show. After your peaceful afternoon tea and Captain's welcome cocktail, you'll end your Aswan excursions.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Start the day off right with a delicious breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise. Then, as your knowledgeable tour guide leads the way, you'll sail to Kom Ombo temple and visit the Temple of the Ptolemies, which was built in the city where elephants were trained for the army and are dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris. After enjoying your lunch on board the boat, you will then continue sailing to Edfu, where you will be met by an escort the thrilling narrative of Osiris and Seth on your tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu, where you'll explore the Edfu Temple and view the scenes of Horus's conflict with the malevolent god Seth.

A delicious meal will be provided on the Nile cruise ship. Then, while taking part in an Egyptian Galabeya Party, we will set sail for Esna.

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

You will travel to Luxor via the Esna lock after having your handy Egypt Nile River Cruise breakfast. You will then have lunch on the boat and continue to savor the flavor of your afternoon tea. During your Luxor day tours, you will be transferred to see Luxor Temple, which was built by several Pharaohs after Amenhotep III of the eighteenth dynasty, and then continue with your Luxor East Bank Tours to see the Karnak Temple, an ancient Egyptian complex You will be greeted by 40 ram-headed sphinxes as you pass the first pylon. It marks the start of the Avenue of the Sphinxes, which led to the Nile and the Temple of Luxor. Following that, you'll continue to enjoy your dinner on the boat while watching an oriental belly dancing performance.

Day 4: Luxor West Bank Tours - Disembarkation

On the final day of your tour, you will be accompanied by a licensed tour guide. You will begin by enjoying your breakfast on a Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor as you take in the scenery.

After that, you will begin Luxor excursions to explore the <u>Valley of the Kings in Luxor</u> and Hatshepsut Temple, which was built by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> at (El-Deir El-Bahari), one of the most powerful rulers of ancient Egypt.
