<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival Cairo

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our tour leader will greet you with a signboard displaying your names. After a tiring flight, it's time to unwind! You'll be transported to your hotel in a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival, you'll receive a welcome drink, and our representative will assist you with you with your check-in. They'll also review your itinerary for the Pyramids, Nile Cruise, and Sharm El Sheikh Luxury Tours with you to confirm and approve pick-up times for each tour. Spend the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids and Saqqara Tour

After breakfast, your private guide will pick you up for your Cairo day tour of the famous Giza Plateau. You'll see the Great Pyramid of Cheops, one of the only surviving monuments from the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. During the <u>Giza pyramids tour</u>, you'll also have an amazing view of the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, the Great Sphinx, and the Valley Temple. If you're interested, you can ride camels as an optional activity.

Next, we'll head to the Saqqara Necropolis to visit the <u>Djoser</u> Step Pyramid Complex, the first building ever constructed from stone in the world. The tour includes entrance to the pyramid of Teti, which has the most magnificent interior among all accessible pyramids, as well as the Tombs of the Nobles at Saqqara. These tombs, built for the husbands of two daughters of King Teti, feature beautifully depicted scenes of ancient Egyptian life on their walls and corridors.

After lunch, we'll drive to Memphis, the capital of the Pharaohs for thousands of years and a religious and cultural center of great importance for 3,000 years of ancient Egyptian civilization. You'll visit the open-air museum famous for its Alabaster Sphinx and see its second-largest attraction, a broken colossal statue of Ramesses II made of 80-ton marble blocks. Finally, we'll return to your hotel in Cairo, where you'll spend the night.

Your meals for the day include breakfast and lunch. Dinner is not included.

Day 3: Aswan Tours

We'll leave early in the morning and take you to Cairo International Airport. Once you arrive in Aswan, our representatives will accompany you to the cruise.

During the day, we'll visit the High Dam and Philae temple before sailing to <u>Kom Ombo.</u> Afternoon tea will be served, and we'll then visit the temple dedicated to Sobek and Haroeris. We'll continue sailing towards Edfu to explore some of Egypt's most attractive temples. Dinner will be provided on the cruise boat, and we'll end the day with a disco party.

You'll spend the night in Edfu, and your meals for the day will include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: Edfu Temple

You'll start your day with breakfast on your luxurious Nile Cruise. We'll then visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u> in <u>Edfu</u>, which is a stunning monument dedicated to Horus, the god of the sky and protector of kingship in ancient Egypt.

We'll cross the lock and sail to Luxor, where you can enjoy afternoon tea while admiring the beautiful scenery. Dinner will be served onboard the cruise boat, and you'll have the chance to attend a fun Galabya party.

You'll spend the night in Luxor, and your meals for the day will include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 5: Luxor Nile Cruise Tours

After breakfast, you'll board a boat to tour the Valley of the Kings, where you can explore the tombs of various dynasties during the New Kingdom period. We'll also visit the Temple of Deir El Bahari, which is one of the most beautiful and iconic temples in Egypt.

After touring the East Bank of Luxor, you might want to visit the Karnak Temple complex, which is home to the throne of Amun-Re, and then explore the Luxor Temple, which features beautiful columns and statues of Ramses the Great.

Later, we'll return to the Nile Cruise and end our journey at the majestic Colossi of Memnon. Lunch will be served onboard the cruise, and you'll spend the night reminiscing about all of the amazing Luxor day tours you took.

In the afternoon, you can enjoy tea while taking in the views. You also have the option to take a hot air balloon ride in Luxor.

Your meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 06: Luxor to Sharm El Sheikh by Flight

After enjoying a delicious breakfast, you'll be transferred to Luxor Airport to check in for your flight to Sharm El Sheikh. Upon arrival in Sharm El Sheikh, you'll check into your hotel and spend the night.

This 480 square kilometer park is located where the Gulf of Suez meets the Gulf of Aqaba in the southernmost part of the Sinai Peninsula. It's

an excellent destination for nature lovers and adventure seekers.

You'll spend the night in Sharm El Sheikh, and your meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 8: Sharm El Sheikh Optional Quad Bike Adventure

You can spend your morning relaxing or, alternatively, join an optional tour at 2 pm. The tour will depart from your hotel and take you to the Quad Bike Centre, where you'll enjoy an exciting ride across the sand dunes of the Sinai desert and take in the breathtaking views.

In the evening, you'll have free time to spend at your hotel. Your meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 9: Sharm El Sheikh Optional Tour to St. Catherine Monastery

If you're looking for something to do in Sharm, we have an optional tour for you. You can visit one of the most beautiful monasteries in Sinai or take a walking tour of Gebel Musa, where Moses received the commandments. The monastery is owned and operated by the Greek Orthodox Church and boasts a library that has the world's second-largest collection of illuminated manuscripts. You'll be able to see the Burning Bush and many antique religious artifacts, which are all worth seeing.

You'll spend the night in Sharm, and your meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 10: Fly Back to Cairo

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh, you'll fly to Cairo for an overnight stay.

Day 11: Cairo City Tour

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel in Cairo, your private guide will accompany you to the Egyptian Museum, which has the largest collection of Egyptian artefacts in the world. After exploring the museum, we'll visit one of Cairo's most famous landmarks—the Saladin Citadel, including the beautiful Mohammed Ali Alabaster Mosque, offering stunning views of the Islamic Parish of Cairo with its centuries-old mosques, minarets, and domes.

Next, we'll head to Coptic Cairo to explore the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, and the church of St. Sergius with its crypt. We'll also visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is believed to be the site where Pharaoh's palace stood and where Moses was found floating in a basket on the Nile.

After lunch, we'll take a trip to Muslim Cairo, exploring the walls and barriers of this ancient city, whose old streets date back to the 10th century. Our walk will end with a cup of tea at the oldest fishawi cafe in Khan el-Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar. At the end of the day, you'll return to your hotel and spend the night in Cairo.

Your meals for the day include breakfast and lunch.

Day 12: Final Departure
