Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), our specialist tour leader will meet you at the luggage belt and assist with your luggage. You'll then be transferred to your hotel in Cairo in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival at your hotel, you'll receive a Welcome Drink and our tour leader will help you with check-in procedures. They will also review your 13-Day Luxury Tour to Cairo and the Oasis itinerary with you. You'll then have a comfortable overnight stay at your hotel in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili

Start your day with a delicious breakfast at your hotel before embarking on your Giza tour. With your knowledgeable tour guide by your side, you'll have an unforgettable experience exploring the Giza Plateau and the Giza Pyramids of Cheops. Beyond these impressive pyramids, you'll discover the remains of Chephren's son and grandson pyramids, as well as the great Sphinx, created by Chephren to protect his necropolis. The final stop on your [Giza pyramids tour](#) will be at the only remaining valley temple from Chephren's pyramid complex.

Next, you'll enjoy a Coptic Cairo tour, visiting the Hanging Church, the Church of St. Sergius or Abu Serga Church, and Ben Ezra Synagogue, all located in the oldest part of Cairo. It's an unforgettable experience that will leave you with lasting memories.

Take a break and enjoy lunch before resuming your Cairo day tours to the Egyptian Museum, which opened in 1902 and houses artifacts from all periods in the history of Egypt. From great statues and huge sarcophagi to the tiniest accessories used by ancient Egyptians, the museum's collection is awe-inspiring. A particular highlight is the golden collection of King Tutankhamun.

Finally, explore one of Cairo's oldest bazaars, Khan el Khalili, on a unique walking tour experience before being transferred back to your hotel at the end of the tour. You'll spend the night in Cairo, with breakfast and lunch included.

Day 3: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

Your day will start with breakfast at around 6 a.m. before checking out to begin your Egypt Desert Safari Trips. Our tour guide will meet you and accompany you in a modern air-conditioned vehicle to Bahariya Oasis, which is about a four-hour drive from Cairo.

When you arrive in Bahariya Oasis, we'll take you on a tour of some of its most fascinating historical sites, including the Museum of Golden Mummies. You'll also get to explore the Tombs of the Nobles, which belonged to the regional rulers of the oasis in ancient times. We'll also visit the Temple of Alexander the Great, built in honor of the famous leader who founded the beautiful city of Alexandria. Lastly, we'll visit the Temple of Muftella, which was dedicated to the god Bis, one of the well-known gods in ancient Egypt. It's a journey back in time that will leave you with a deeper appreciation of Egypt's rich history and culture.

Lunch will be served in a Bedouin-style restaurant, and then we'll check in at the hotel, leaving the afternoon free for you to relax and explore the oasis on your own.

Before sunset, we'll start ascending the black mountain to see the ruins on top of the mountain, known as "the English House," where you can enjoy the picturesque view of Bahariya Oasis during sunset.

You'll spend the night in Bahariya, with breakfast, lunch, and dinner included.

Day 4: White Desert and Black Desert

After breakfast, you'll embark on the beautiful salt lake to enjoy the stunning views and take some memorable photos. You'll also get to experience climbing palm trees, just like the locals do, and admire the golden sand dunes.

The first stop on your journey to the White Desert will be at the Black Desert, which is a region full of volcanic mountains covered with volcanic rocks. Next, you'll visit the Valley of El Haize, located south of Bawiti and Bahariya.

You'll also have the opportunity to see the quartz crystal at the Crystal Mountain area and spend some time in the charming Valley of Agabat. Later, you'll camp in the White Desert, surrounded by the stunning white limestone and chalk formations of the western desert.

In the evening, you'll enjoy a Bedouin-style dinner in the desert, with the natural beauty of the landscape as your backdrop. Your meals for the day, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner, are all included.

Day 5: Farafra and Dakhla Oases

Enjoy a traditional morning tea with mint made by locals during breakfast before heading to Farafra Oasis. Here, you can relax in the sulfur-hot water spring of Bir Setah while taking in the beautiful surroundings. You'll also visit the unique mud brick museum of local artist Badr and explore the old town of Al Qasr before driving to Dakhla to visit the Roman Temple of Deir El Hagar, which dates back to the 26th dynasty.

After lunch, take a stroll through the charming Islamic village of Al Qasr, where you can see old houses, an oil press, wheat grinder, courthouse, medieval prison, schools, and Ayyubid mosques. Spend the day relaxing at the hot spring resort of Oasis Hot Springs, and then head to the green Dakhla Farms to watch the sunset at the edge of the Great Sand Sea.

If you're looking for a romantic escape, consider spending the night at the Desert Lodge Hotel in Dakhla, where you can take in the beautiful views of the lush green village and the Rose Mountains from atop a cliff.

Your meals for the day, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner, are all included.

Day 6: Kharga Oasis

On the sixth day of your trip, you'll visit Kharga Oasis after enjoying a delicious breakfast. Your tour will start in Dakhla Oasis, where you'll explore Qasr El Labkha, a Roman fortress on the famous 40-day road that connected Egypt and Sudan. You'll also visit the Kharga Museum and the Temple of Hibis with its well-preserved Nadura Roman Exterior.

Next, you'll head to Bagawat, which is the oldest Christian cemetery in the world, featuring chapels painted with still-preserved Old Testament murals. You'll also visit the Baris Oasis, the smallest and cutest of the Western Desert Oases, where you'll see the Temple of Dush, which is devoted to Isis and Serapis and guarded the 40-day road when it was functioning.

Camping in the golden sand dunes of Kharga is an unforgettable experience. The campsites are spacious and comfortable, and there are plenty of activities to enjoy in the area, such as hiking, swimming, and birdwatching.

Your meals for the day, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner, are all included.

Day 7: Kharga to Luxor, East Bank Tours

As you sail to Edfu, enjoy a delicious lunch on board the Nile cruise ship, followed by a relaxing dinner.
