Day 1: Arrive to Cairo / Egypt Luxury Vacations

Day 8: Cairo Tour

Visitors can see the Treasures of the Golden Pharaoh Tutankhamen, which are still intact and awe-inspiring. We also recommend visiting the Citadel of Saladin, which includes the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque. It provides mesmerizing panoramic views of the ancient mosques, minarets, and domes of Islamic Cairo. You can admire the mosque's stunning architecture and intricate decorations, which is a massive construction.

We recommend taking the Cairo Day Tours to explore the Coptic area of Cairo. You'll have the opportunity to visit several ancient landmarks such as the Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church suspended over its old towers, and the Church of St. Sergius, also known as the Cavern church or the holy family church. The catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, from the Roman period, are another fascinating landmark. The Bibliotheca of Alexandria, an ancient library and educational hub, is also on the itinerary, as well as two historical statues—the Alexandria statue for the unknown soldier and the statue of Alexander the Great.

As you drive down Cornish Avenue, you'll cross the Stanley Bridge, a stunning landmark in modern Alexandria, and see the city from above. We'll drive back to Cairo and stay overnight in the hotel. You'll have breakfast and lunch provided.
