Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive to Cairo Airport

Welcome to Cairo, Egypt

Cairo Top Tours tour leader will be expecting you upon arrival at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> luggage belt, and he will be holding a signboard bearing your name and the company's logo. Then you will be transferred by your personal driver and a private air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel in Cairo. At the hotel, your tour leader will assist you in check-in as soon as possible and revise your Egypt tour itinerary with you to assure the pick-up times for each day of your Egypt Day Tours.

Spend the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids and the highlights of Cairo Tour

Take your nice breakfast at your hotel in the early morning, then get ready to be accompanied by your Egyptologist guide to the Giza Plateau and enjoy the <u>tour to Giza Pyramids</u> of <u>Cheops</u> of the <u>fourth dynasty</u>, built over 4500 years ago by the hands of 100,000 men and it is considered the largest between the 3 Pyramids of Giza. Behind it, you will see the <u>pyramids</u> of his son Chephren and the third pyramid of King <u>Mycerinus</u>, <u>The Great Sphinx</u> made by king Chephren to be the guardian of the necropolis, and the only (almost intact) surviving <u>Valley Temple</u> which is part of Chephren's pyramid complex in Giza at the end of your <u>Giza pyramids tour</u>.

You will go to the oldest part in Cairo to enjoy an amazing <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> and visit <u>The Hanging Church</u>, which was built above the ruins of the old Fortress of Babylon, <u>the church of St Sergius</u> or Abu Serga church, in addition to <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which was a Coptic church before it was converted into a Jewish synagogue in 882 A.D.

Take a rest while having your lunch served in an oriental restaurant. After that, we will resume Cairo day tours to <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, which was opened in 1902 as the first antiquities museum in Cairo. The museum houses artifacts from all periods in the <u>history of Egypt</u> between great statues and huge sarcophagi to the tiniest accessories used by ancient Egyptians.

Finally, you will be taken to the oldest bazaar in Cairo for an unusual Cairo shopping tour experience in the market of Khan El Khalili which is one of the most visited sites during the Islamic Cairo trips.

You will be transferred back to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 3 : Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

Around 06:00 AM, take your breakfast and check out to start your <u>Egypt Desert Safari Trips</u>, you will meet Cairo Top Tours Egyptologist guide to accompany you by a modern air-conditioned vehicle to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> about 4 hours drive from Cairo. Upon arrival, visit the valley of <u>Golden Mummies</u>, the Tombs of the Nobles or regional rulers of the oasis in ancient times, the temple of <u>Alexander The Great</u> who built the beautiful city of Alexandria, and <u>the Temple of Muftella</u> dedicated to <u>God Bis</u> one of the famous <u>gods of ancient Egypt</u> to be worshipped in the desert places as the god of entertainment and pleasure.

Delicious lunch meals will be served in a Bedouin-style restaurant, after that we will go to the hotel to check in and spend the afternoon freely.

You will start ascending the black mountain by a 4-wheel drive before the sunset to see the ruins on top of the mountain, "the English House" enjoying the picturesque view of Bahariya Oasis during sunset.

Overnight in Bahariya.

Day 4: White & Black Desert Trip

Start your day with breakfast, then head to the incredible Salt Lake for stunning views and photo opportunities. Explore the golden dunes and learn to climb palm trees like the locals to pick fresh seasonal fruit while strolling through the lovely gardens.

Next, set off on an adventure to the White Desert. First, visit the Black Desert, a region with volcano-shaped mountains covered in volcanic rocks, and then explore the Valley of El Haize south of Bawiti and Bahariya. Stop to admire the quartz at Crystal Mountain and spend some time in the picturesque Valley of Agabat.

Camp overnight in the White Desert, surrounded by magnificent white limestone and chalk formations, and enjoy a Bedouin dinner under the moon and stars.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 5: Farafra & Dakhla Oases Tour

Start your day with a breakfast prepared by locals and enjoy the popular morning mint tea. Then, head to Farafra Oasis to enjoy the sulfur hot spring of Bir Setah and visit the unique mud brick museum of local artist Badr. Explore the old town of Al Qasr before driving to Dakhla, about a 3-hour journey. In Dakhla, visit the Roman Temple of Deir El Hagar, which dates back to the 26th dynasty and was completed by Roman emperors. Explore the rock-cut tombs at the Roman burial ground of El Muzawwaqqa.

After lunch, visit the old Islamic village of Al Qasr, dating back to the 12th century, to see ancient houses, narrow alleys, the old oil press, wheat grinder, court, prison, school, and Ayyubid mosque.

Relax by the pool-like hot spring in the afternoon, then visit the Dakhla farms, filled with golden dunes, and enjoy the sunset on the edge of the Great Sand Sea with a cup of Bedouin tea.

Spend the night in Dakhla at the Desert Lodge Hotel, atop a cliff overlooking the green village and the beautiful rose mountains that Dakhla Oasis is known for.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 6: Kharga Oasis

Today, you will visit Kharga Oasis. Enjoy your breakfast and get prepared to begin your tour at Dakhla Oasis by visiting Qasr El Labkha, a Roman fortress on the old caravan route the famous 40 days road attaching Egypt with Sudan (DARB EL ARBEIN), and the Kharga Museum. After that, visit the Roman Temple of Hibis and Nadura from outside as well as Bagawat the oldest Christian cemetery all over the world with its chapels painted with biblical murals from the Old Testament still preserving their colors.

We will head to Baris Oasis, the smallest and the cutest of the Western Desert Oases. Visit the Temple of Dush standing in the middle of an entire flourishing settlement guarding the forty days road when it was functioning you still can see most of the details of this Roman settlement like the residential area with mudbrick houses, The fortress, the Temple which is devoted to Isis and Serapis.

Enjoy camping in the middle of the golden sand dunes in Kharga.

Day 7: Kharga \ Luxor (East Bank)

Enjoy your breakfast in the middle of the golden sand dunes, then you will be transferred by an air-conditioned vehicle to <u>Luxor</u>, about 6 hours drive. Upon arrival to Luxor embark on your 5 stars <u>Egypt Nile</u> River Cruise.

Your tasty lunch will be served aboard the Nile cruise ship, start <u>Luxor day tours</u> and especially the <u>East Bank of Luxor tour</u> as you will visit <u>Karnak Temple</u> which is one of the biggest man-made temples in the entire world, and the great temple of King Amenhotep III, the popular <u>Luxor temple</u> that was built by many kings of ancient Egypt.

Enjoy your tasty dinner, and overnight in Luxor.

Day 8:Luxor West Bank

Aboard the Nile river cruise, you will enjoy your savory breakfast viewing the Nile River to continue your Egypt Travel Packages. Begin the <u>west bank of Luxor tour</u> to the two colossal statues of Amenhotep III renowned as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, and then visit the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, the burial ground of 62 pharaohs of the New Kingdom including the famous king Tutankhamen and legendary King Ramses II, the tombs were cut from the mountain, decorated with fascinating paintings and filled in with treasures the Pharaohs were planning to enjoy in the afterlife. Make sure you will go to see the Temple of Hatshepsut well-known as the temple of El Deir El Bahary, the first female ruler in the history of Egypt.

Your lunch will be served on board while sailing to Edfu. Enjoy a leisurely dinner aboard the Nile cruise.

Overnight aboard your Nile Cruise.

Day 9: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Start your day with breakfast aboard the Nile cruise. Visit the well-preserved Edfu Temple, dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed sky god. Sail to Kom Ombo to explore the unique Temple of Kom Ombo, built in honor of the crocodile god Sobek. Enjoy lunch on board as you continue sailing to Aswan.

In the evening, have dinner and stay overnight on the Nile cruise.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 10: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Start your day with a delightful breakfast on the Nile cruise. Begin your Aswan tour with a visit to the renowned High Dam, an engineering feat and a pivotal project in modern Egypt. Next, take a scenic motorboat ride to the Temple of Philae, dedicated to Goddess Isis, beautifully situated on an island. Please continue to the granite quarries to see the Unfinished Obelisk, the largest known obelisk, where ancient kings sourced their stone blocks.

Enjoy dinner on board and spend the night in Aswan.

Day 11: Disembarkation / Back to Cairo

After breakfast, check out from your Nile River Cruise. Enjoy some free time in Aswan or opt for an additional tour to visit Abu Simbel by land. Later, could you transfer to the Aswan railway station for your journey to Cairo on the Sleeping Train? Dinner will be served on the train.
