Day 1: Arrival Cairo

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, a Cairo Top Tours representative will be there to greet you, holding a signboard with your name for easy recognition. Your adventure begins right away with a visit to the world-renowned Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, the oldest known stone structure in the world. Built by the brilliant architect Imhotep, this pyramid marks a significant development in ancient Egyptian architecture. As you explore Saqqara, located about 27 km southwest of Cairo, you'll also have the chance to visit the Mastaba Tombs of the Nobles, tracing the evolution of burial practices throughout ancient Egyptian history.

After a fascinating morning, you'll enjoy a delicious lunch at a charming local restaurant, followed by a visit to the ancient capital of Memphis, Egypt's Old Kingdom capital. In Memphis, you'll witness the grandeur of the Colossal Statue of Ramses II and the impressive Alabaster Sphinx, the second-largest sphinx in Egypt after the Great Sphinx of Giza. Memphis was founded by King Menes, who unified Upper and Lower Egypt over 5,000 years ago, marking the beginning of Egypt's dynastic history.

After a full day of exploration, you will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo for check-in and a relaxing evening.

Day 2: Cairo Sightseeing
