The "Frankincense burner" is a delight to observe at night with its full illumination. After that, we will pass Mohammad Al Ameen Mosque, a spectacular building that looks impressive under the night lights.

Next, extend to the Al Alam Palace of His Majesty Sultan Qaboos, the most prominent attraction in Muscat, for a photo stop. The building with white, blue, and gold facade, decorated iron gates, and fascinating lightning by night now serves ceremonial purposes. You will then enjoy a menu dinner of local delicacies, along with a special lemon and mint drink (no alcohol is served).
